Wyandottes are a great dual-purpose breed, offering both excellent egg and meat production. Hens offer an abundance of brown eggs and cockerels are often able to be harvested for meat earlier than many other heavy breeds of chickens.

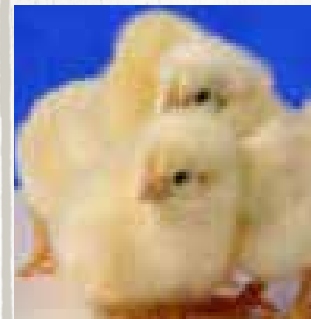
