Cochins are known for excessive plumage that cover their legs and feet. The skin beneath the feathers is yellow and the egg color is light brown. Cochins are known to be good pet hens for the garden, as they are tame and regarded as one of the friendliest, calm and quite chicken breeds and are available in a wide range of colors.
